

RURAL CHARITY OUTREACH PROJECT 2007

The Sarawak British Alumni Association (SBAA) intends to give back to the community through a Rural Charity Outreach Project.

The committee has identified the remote village of Long Singut as the first recipient of this programme. Being a Kenyah settlement close to the Malaysian-Indonesian border, a journey by boat to the settlement from Kapit town takes about two days, depending on the Sungai Balleh tide. The village has no road access, schools, clinics or hospitals. Prior to a tragic helicopter crash in 2005, the village was frequented by flying doctors. Since then, a "No-Fly-Zone" has been imposed on the area and as such, decreasing visits by medical personnel due to its inaccessibility.
